# BY-LAWS AND REGULATIONS

---

**PRO-SHOP:** 9560 7806

**PROFESSIONAL: Geoff George** 9560 7806

Committee meetings are held on the first Wednesday of each month at 7.30pm, all members are welcome to attend.

The Rules of Golf as laid down from time to time by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club at St. Andrews, The Victorian Golf Association and the Victorian Golf League shall apply.

**The conduct of all play on the course is vested in the Match Committee.**

## **Local Rules**

### **Interference from tree roots:**

- “If a player’s ball in the general area has interference from tree roots in the fairway or in the rough, free relief to a distance of 1 club length from the reference point is available under Rule 16.1b. But interference does not exist if the tree roots only interfere with the player’s stance.”  
Apply rule, only after consultation with your marker.

### **Lost Ball short version**

- When a player’s ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds or identify (lost), the player may proceed under the Stroke and Distance Local Rule for a penalty of two strokes, rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. This Local Rule is not available if a provisional ball has been played.

For further local rules, please review them online or on the back a Score card.

---

### **1. Before commencing play:**

Members are to use the OneGolf computer system to register for the daily competition and use the handicap shown on the monitor.

The competition for the day is shown on the Registration Monitor, Miscore App, Syllabus and the Website.

Should the computer not be operating, record your Name and Golf Link number (last three or four digits) onto Starter Sheet form provided and use handicap as shown on Handicap Board.

Any player who has not performed all the tasks detailed above will be ineligible for that event.

Completion of Round:

Each member must enter their score into the computer after completion of their round and place their scorecard in the box provided or Submit their score via Miclub. Once the card has been posted, it is irretrievable.

To be eligible for daily competitions, cards must be returned by 2:00 p.m.

### **2. The count back system is an integral part of the OneGolf system we use, and therefore a tie will be determined by the system.**

First count back – best score for the last nine holes.

Second count back over the last six holes.

Third count back over the last three holes.

If still a tie, then the best score for the last 6 holes, if still tied the last 3 holes, if there is still a tie the 9<sup>th</sup> hole of the first 9 holes.

If this process does result in a winner, the Match Committee is to decide the winner, either declare as a tie, or alternatively decide the winner by chance (such as tossing a coin).

N.B. Ties in Club Championships will be decided by an 18-hole play-off.

### **3. Divisions for competitions will be displayed on the Competition and Weekly Results Sheet**

- 4. To qualify for the Club Championship event, Members must:**
  - a. Submit a minimum of 8 live scores in club competition with in the 10 months prior to commencement of the championship.
  - b. A maximum of 2 live score cards for each of the last two 30 day periods prior to the commencement of the championship event may, if needed, count towards the 8 scores required.
  - c. Have been a full financial member for at least 3 months prior to the commencement of the championship event.
  - d. NOTE: A “live score” is a score recorded in an individual handicapped event and does not include Pennant and Challenge matches.
  
- 5. Members competing in club competitions must have their cards signed by a Member, Guest [refer 6 (a)] or another person as authorised by the Match Committee.**
  
- 6. Guests and Members can play in competitions under the following conditions and rules**
  - a. Guest must be a financial member of an affiliated body (e.g. VGL, VGA, etc.) and must hold a current Golf Australia handicap.  
Note: The Glen Waverley Golf Club Inc. does not recognise the Golf Pass handicap.
  - b. A Guest must be in the company of a Member.
  - c. A Guest can play a maximum of six times during the year.
  - d. His/her home club shall be named on the card.
  - e. A Guest must comply with the daily competition rules.
  - f. Guests are not eligible to compete in Major Club or Medal events.
  - g. All guests shall enter their details into the Guest Book, located adjacent to the starter desk area before play.
  - h. The Guest’s entry to be accompanied by the appropriate fee.
  - i. Guest’s handicap cannot exceed 36 (Men) or 45 (Ladies).
  
- 7. Any protest must be lodged in writing with the Captain or a Match Committee member before the competition has closed and the results posted.**

Exceptions: When a competitor has returned a score on any hole, better than actually taken (Rule 3.3b), when a competitor has recorded a handicap on the score card other than he was entitled to (Rule 3.2c), if the competitor was in breach of Rule 1.3, waiving a rule of golf, or when a competitor has returned a score better than that recorded by the winner (Rule 3.3b).

---

Such protests must be lodged in writing to the Captain or the Secretary no later than 7 days after the date of the competition and must contain the grounds upon which it is made.

- 8. A minimum of seven (7) days from the date of the competition must elapse before daily trophies are awarded.**
- 9. A member who belongs to any other VGA or VGL club must elect one club as their “home club”. The handicapper of that club then becomes responsible for their handicap. Scores in competitions, away from the “home club”, must be forwarded by the member to the handicapper, together with the D.S.R. for that competition.**
- 10. All members and their guests must adhere to the club’s dress requirements.**

## **PERSONAL INSURANCE**

The annual fee paid by each member includes a personal insurance levy that is valid when playing at a course anywhere within Australia. The levy includes: personal liability to a third party (person or property), personal accident insurance and expense insurance.

# GWGC BY-LAWS

---

Listed below are the basic rules of etiquette that should be observed by all players.

1. No one should stand close to or directly behind the ball or directly behind the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
2. Glen Waverley Golf Club Inc. promotes ready golf at all times.
3. No player should play a shot until the group in front is out of range. In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
4. Players should always show consideration for other players on the course and should not disturb their play by moving, talking or making unnecessary noise.
5. Players while searching for a ball should allow other matches coming up to pass them, and having given the signal to play through, should not continue their play until these players have passed and are out of range.
6. After having played out of a bunker a player should carefully fill up all holes made by him therein.
7. On the putting green any pitch marks made by his ball are to be repaired.
8. Players should not drop the flag stick on the putting green thus ensuring no damage is done to the putting surface and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing too close, or in taking out and replacing the flag stick. The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green. Golf bags and buggies should not be dropped on or pulled across the putting green.
9. When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the putting green and should not retry their putts or practice putting.
10. In order to keep the game moving at an enjoyable tempo the player who has the honour at the next tee should immediately walk to that tee and tee his ball up, leaving the replacing of the flag stick to one of the other members of the group.

N.B. the greatest amount of time lost/wasted during a round of golf is between the GREEN and the TEE.

11. It is the duty and responsibility of the lowest handicapped player in the match to see his fellow competitors replace all divots, smooth out all foot marks in bunkers and observe the etiquette of the game.
  12. It is the duty and responsibility of all members to carry and use a Sand Bucket. During the winter months replace divot and cover with sand. In summer just fill divot hole with sand.

N.B. The Low Marker is the Team Captain PENNANT - MEN

# GWGC BY-LAWS

---

## **PENNANT - MEN**

The Glen Waverley Golf Club Inc. generally fields three men's pennant teams each year. Pennant is normally played in a home and away format over six matches however this may be altered by the VGL in situations where more than 4 teams are registered in a particular division.

Each competition round every selected player will be required to wear the Glen Waverley Golf Club Inc. pennant shirt and black trousers or shorts when representing the club (for both home and away matches). Each player must furnish his own Club shirt, black trousers or shorts. The club will pay all green fees for all players for home matches and will also supply refreshments and food for all players and caddies. Players will also be required to provide a salad for home events on a rotational basis (max 2).

When playing away the host club will be responsible for green fees, refreshments and food.

Caddies or players who are not selected in that event are welcome and encouraged to participate and support the club.

All members of the GWGC are welcome to register for Pennant Team selection, providing they meet certain eligibility requirements.

### **Eligibility of a Player**

The VGL have rules relevant to players being a bona-fide player, both financial and playing club games. GWGC also require players to have:

- Been financial for 3 months prior to the first pennant game of the season.
- As of the 1st October until the first round of pennant, must have returned at least 6 cards in singles competition played at Glen Waverley.

Eligibility requirements may vary for Juniors at the discretion of the Match Committee. The Match Committee recognises that the primary objective of fielding pennant teams is to win pennant flags. Whilst playing pennant is a great way for members to become more involved with the club, and also for them to have the opportunity to represent the club in a competitive environment, this primary objective must be considered paramount. As such team Captains and Vice Captains will be instructed to select teams they consider best equipped to achieve this primary objective.



---

## **Selection of Team**

- The Club Captain will nominate each Pennant sides Captain, after consultation with the match committee.
- Once the pennant sides Captains have been confirmed, the team selection process will be finalized and a notification will be publicised to all prospective players
- All selected players must attend a team meeting prior to the beginning of the pennant season where the requirements and responsibilities of being a member of a GWGC pennant team will be explained. Each team will be required to elect a Vice Captain to assist the Captain in team selection, running of the team, organization of clerical duties and making arrangements for catering for home games. Team members will also be asked to confirm their availability dates for each match/round pertaining to their team.
- Team selection for each pennant team for each match is at the sole discretion of the Captain and Vice-Captain of each team. The Match Committee cannot override or participate in team selection for any match. Team selection for each match will be advised to all team core members at least three (3) days prior to the event date.
- For clarification of members, the following information will be displayed weekly on the Pennant Notice Board and be available by the Saturday morning following each round of pennant:
  - Results from completed matches
  - A player performance chart
  - The current pennant ladders.

## **Eligibility to play in Pennant Finals**

VGL pennant rules stipulate that a player must have played in at least two (2) of the qualifying pennant matches to be eligible for selection in a pennant final (where there are least four (4) teams in the relevant pennant division). In situations where there may be less than four (4) such teams this criteria reduces to only one (1) qualifying match.

Pennant team selection for all qualifying matches will be made based on picking the best team to win on the day. As such the Match Committee cannot guarantee that all players will play the prerequisite two (2) matches to qualify to play in a pennant final. Match Committee

## CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Club Champion 0-54

B Grade 15-20

C Grade 21-54

All grades including the Veterans (60 years and over) and Junior (under 21 years) will consist of 72 holes of stroke play. The champion for all events is the person who returns the lowest 72 hole total gross score for that event.

Note Winner of the Veteran grade may be asked to provide proof of age at the completion of the event.

All members must comply with eligibility requirements as per section E1 of "Conditions of Competition".

## PLAY-OFFS

All ties for champion in championship events to be decided by 18 hole play-off. The Club Captain will arrange the time and date of the play-off.

## **LADIES Eligibility to Win Competitions**

To be eligible to win a weekly competition, a trophy event, a monthly medal or the club championship, a member must be financial at the time of the event. Further eligibility requires payment of a \$3.00 competition fee for 18 hole players and a \$1 competition fee for 9 hole players.

In addition to the above, to be eligible for a trophy event, monthly medal or club championship, a new player after obtaining their handicap they are then required to play 8 games to secure a settled handicap.

The monthly medal, medal of medalists and club championships are major competitions - should any of these events result in a tie, the Captain will arrange a date and time for a play-off.

Visitors/Guests are warmly invited to play in Ladies weekly competitions. However, a visitor is ineligible to win the competition. Glen Waverley Bowl, Guest and Charity Day and Monash Cup are exceptions.

## **Registering Intent to Complete**

Members are to use the OneGolf computer system to register for the daily competition and use the handicap shown on the monitor.

The competition for the day will be shown on the Registration Monitor, Miscore App, Syllabus and the Website.

Should the computer not be operating, record your Name and Golf Link number (last three or four digits) onto Starter Sheet form provided and use handicap as shown on Handicap Board.

Any player who has not performed all the tasks detailed above will be ineligible for that event.

## **Completion of Round:**

Each member must enter their score into the computer after completion of their round and place her scorecard in the box provided or Submit their score via the Miscore App. Once the score has been posted, it is irretrievable.

Special Awards (not listed in daily syllabus)

Birdie and Gobbler Trophies

These trophies are awarded to the player with the most Birdies or the most Gobblers accrued over the competition year - January to December.

Separate trophies are awarded for Wednesday and Saturday competitions.

# GWGC LADIES BY-LAWS

---

## Handicaps for Grades:

“A” 0 – 27,

“B” 28 – 32,

“C” 33 – 54.

Handicaps are calculated by taking the best 8 differentials (differential = gross score – AWCR) of a player’s 20 most recent valid scores, the result of which is multiplied by 0.93. It is irrelevant when these 20 scores were achieved, so handicaps can no longer lapse.

Minimum Number for Competition:

Wednesday	Weekly competitions	8 players
	Major competitions	12 players
Saturday	Weekly competitions	4 players
	Major competitions	4 players

For smaller fields there will be a ball competition only.

Three grades apply to all weekly competitions where the field comprises 20 players or more.

For fields less than 20 players there will be a winner for each of 2 grades.

The 2 grades will depend on numbers and could be:

Grade A - Grades (B&C) combined

Grades (A&B) combined - Grade C

Grades (A&C) combined - Grade B

Monthly Medal and Major Trophy Competitions

For Monthly Medal Competitions there will be a winner and runner-up.

All medal winners will be eligible to play for the Medal of Medalists at the end of the year. In the event of a draw, a play off will be arranged.

For Trophy events there will be a winner and a runner up.

For Grandmother’s Trophy there will be a winner and a runner up. A prize will also be awarded to the best score from the remainder of the field.

If course condition requires tee up on all holes there will be no Monthly Medal or Trophy competition. If there are sufficient players a club competition will be held.

---

## **Monthly Medal – first and subsequent medals – Procedure:**

When a player wins her first medal, she receives the GWGC medal pin. After winning a second medal, the original medal is put on a bar, and a third and subsequent medals are represented by stars engraved on the bar.

### **Leave of Absence:**

If through sickness or prolonged holiday, a member is unable to play, they are requested to notify a committee member of their absence, either in person, by phone or via email. This is to avoid unnecessary concern about members who have been absent for some time.

Please note: All competitions are subject to change by the Match Committee or at the discretion of the Lady Captain.

### **Starting Time – 2025:**

Wednesday: 7.30 – 8.30am

Saturday: As per Booking Sheet online

Players are required at the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee 15 minutes before their assigned tee-off time. If a player is not ready to tee off on time, they will lose their slot and may have to play at the end of the field.

### **Notice to all Members:**

If a player is unable to play on Wednesday, the Pro-Shop should be notified before 7:30 AM.

# GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED

---

## **Stroke (Medal)**

The score at each hole is entered on the scorecard, totaled and the player's full handicap deducted. The player who completes the stipulated round in the fewest net strokes is the winner.

## **Par**

In Par play the score is entered on the scorecard in the same way as stroke play with the exception that, where the score exceeds par for the hole, after allowing for handicap stroke, the score need not be entered. It is the custom that when a player is beaten by par on a hole the ball shall be picked up.

(This helps speed up play).

After entering the stroke score on the card, a result is marked, in the column beside that score, with a "+" sign for a win, an "0" sign for a half and a "-" for a loss. At the end of the round the plus and minus signs are totaled and the nett result written as so many "up", "down" or square. A player is allowed his/her full stroke handicap and the strokes are taken at holes indicated on the stroke index on the scorecard. Where the player's handicap is more than 18, two or more strokes will be allowed on the number of holes that the handicap exceeds 18. These strokes will be taken in the same order as followed for the first 18 holes unless the stroke index on the card goes beyond 18.

## **Stableford**

The most popular method of playing Stableford is for the player to take strokes at holes as in a Par competition (using full handicap) and to score points for the net result at each hole. At the end of the round all points are totaled and the player having the highest number of points is the winner. In scoring, after allowing for handicap, a player who scores par on a hole receives 2 points, for 1 over par – 1 point, for 1 under par – 3 points, for 2 under par – 4 points and so on.

## **Foursomes**

Two players play as partners using the same ball. The players strike the ball alternatively during the play of each hole. Players also alternate striking the ball from consecutive tees. Scoring is done as for a stroke round and the total is subject to a deduction of half the players combined handicap.

N.B. If either player incurs a penalty stroke it does not alter rotation of play. In a foursome competition consisting of more than one stipulated round, the order of play may be changed between rounds unless the Match Committee decides that the original order of play must be preserved throughout the competition.

# GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED

---

All the foregoing competitions are forms of stroke play and are subject to the rules governing stroke play. Special rules for Par and Stableford competitions are set out in Rule 21. Rule 23 covers the special rules for four-ball Par and Stableford competitions. Rule 22 is relevant to Foursome competition

## **Chapman Foursomes**

Both players play tee-shots at each hole, then play a second shot with their own ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in foursomes, with the partner of the selected ball playing the third shot. Handicap is half the aggregate stroke handicap.

## **Canadian Foursomes**

Played as above except that after both players play tee-shots at each hole, one ball is selected and the partner of the selected ball plays the second shot.

## **Aggregate Stableford**

Two players play as partners each recording a score on each hole. Individual stroke and score at each hole must be recorded on the scorecard. The competition result is the aggregate points scored by each team. Only one scorecard is required per partnership.

## **Ambrose Competition**

A team stroke event usually played by four, three or two players. Each player plays a tee-shot at each hole. The team Captain, usually the low marker, then selects the ball in the best position for the next shot. For the second (and subsequent) shots, the other players of the team are to play their own ball **WITHIN ONE CLUB LENGTH** of the selected ball no nearer the hole. Balls are to be dropped in the normal manner. Balls may be played in any order, however the selected ball must not be moved from its original position. If the selected ball is in the rough or a hazard, **ALL** players must drop their balls in the rough or the hazard. This procedure of selecting the best ball position continues until a ball is holed. When on the green the balls are placed within 15 centimeters of the selected ball position.

Handicap allowance of the team aggregate stroke handicap is:

1/8<sup>th</sup> for a team of four;

1/6<sup>th</sup> for a team of three; and

1/4<sup>th</sup> for a team of two.

N.B. Each player must have his/her drive selected a minimum of three times and recorded on the scorecard. Failure to do so results in disqualification. At the completion of the round only two players need sign the scorecard

# GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED

## **Irish Foursomes**

Irish Foursomes is a Stableford teams event played by two, three or four players. Each player plays an individual game of Stableford and at the completion of each hole the best two (2) scores are totaled and that combined score is recorded on the scorecard. Of course, a team of four players has an advantage having four scores to choose from.

At the completion of the round only two players need sign the scorecard.

## **4BBB Stableford**

Two players play as partners, each taking stokes at holes as in a stableford competition. Only the best score on each hole is entered on the score card. Care must be taken to indicate which player had the best score on each hole by marking the score in separate columns, headed with the initials of the player. If the scores are mixed and it is impossible for the Match Committee to determine who scored what/when, both players will be disqualified.

N.B. In four-ball events a player should discontinue play of a hole if he/she cannot better the partner's score.

## **4BBB Stableford - Multiplier**

Two players play as partners, each taking stokes at holes as in a stableford competition. Both player's stroke and stableford scores on each hole are entered on the score card with each player's stroke and stableford score shown on the card. Each player's score must be shown by marking each player's score in separate columns, The team result for the hole is then calculated by multiplying the stableford points achieved by each player together. EG If Player 1 scores 4 for 3 points and Player 2 scores 5 for 2 points then the team score for the hole is 3 points X 2 points = 6 points. Similarly, a 4 for 3 and a 7 for zero = zero points for the hole as 3 times zero is zero.

At the end of the round the total score fore each hole is added together and the team with the highest number of aggregate points wins the daily competition.

## **Irish Teams**

Irish teams is a stableford teams event played by three or four players. Each player plays an individual game of stableford. Scoring is as follows:

On Par 3 holes the best individual score is recorded.

On Par 4 holes the best two scores are recorded.

On Par 5 holes the best three scores are recorded.

Care must be taken to indicate on the card which player(s) had the best score on each hole by marking the player score(s) in separate columns on the card with each player's initials shown at the top of each column. At the competition of the round the group with the highest combined aggregate score is the winner
